

Message from the Town Manager

March was a busy month as the Town continues to improve Dewey Beach making it "A Way of Life".

The Town has several different projects ongoing which include:

- The Dewey Wave Center Island Project. All posts are in and top soil is being added for the plants
- The Sign Beautification Project. White vinyl posts are replacing metal posts and reducing the number of signs on the streets.
- The Ocean Side Street Project with improvements on Bellevue Street, Van Dyke Avenue, and soon to be on Carolina Street. If your street is interested in these type of improvements please contact the Town Manager.
- The Stormwater Street Projects will continue on Read Avenue, Bayard Avenue, and McKinley Avenue to replace and clean damaged stormwater pipes.
- Fireworks over the bay are taking place on April 8th.
- The Dagsworthy Avenue project is completed with pervious asphalt and parking lines.
 If you should have any questions about any of the projects please call the Town Manager.
- The Town met with the new Verizon wireless representative, Bob McGuckin, to discuss a
 timeline for moving the 5G poles off the dunes. The Town explained the wireless
 application and portal process and asked Verizon to start the applications immediately.
 Verizon advised that their engineers are still reviewing the Town's Wireless ordinance and
 hope to start the process soon.
- The Town is working with both Federal and State Agencies to obtain grants for the new Town Hall/Police Station and Infrastructure Stormwater Projects.
- The portable Pedestrian Crosswalk Signs will go back up before April 8th on SR-1 and on King Charles Street.

Accommodation Tax News

On March 18, 2022, the Dewey Beach Town Council voted to approve a contract with GovOS Short Term Rental Compliance software. This program performs routine sweeps of over thirty rental listing websites to identify short-term rental properties, and verify that those accommodations are licensed with the town. Town staff plans to implement this software for the 2022 summer season. A reminder to property owners that the license year begins May 1st, and to be sure to submit your rental license applications prior to this date. For your convenience, you may submit your rental application and payment online at www.townofdeweybeach.com.



Accommodation Tax due on accommodations provided between October 1st and March 31st is **due to the town by April 15th**.

Accommodations Tax Rate: 3% of the total gross proceeds derived from the rental
