

It was another great summer in Dewey Beach! I want to thank our Police Department and Beach Patrol for keeping us safe this summer. They did an outstanding job! Our maintenance team did a great job keeping the town operating and clean through rain or shine.

I also want to thank everyone for their donations to the Rehoboth Beach Volunteer Fire Company. This year with the town's match we raised almost \$20,000! The donation check will be presented to the Fire Chief at the End of Season Beach Party. A special thanks to one resident on the first block of West Street for their gracious donation of \$5,000.00! The new Town Hall and Police Station is moving along with walls being poured this week. Pending weather and material, we hope to have the roof on by Thanksgiving!

NO ELECTION TO BE HELD IN 2025

The Town of Dewey Beach WILL NOT hold its Annual Municipal Election on Saturday, September 20, 2025.

No other persons except the (3) incumbents are on file for the (3) Commissioner seats. Therefore, it is determined by the Dewey Beach Board of Elections that it is not necessary to hold an election.

Pursuant to Section 10(a) of the Charter of the Town of Dewey Beach and certified by the Dewey Beach Board of Elections, the incumbent Commissioners Paul Bauer, Elisabeth Gibbings, and David Jasinski shall be deemed elected for a full two (2) year term each.

He has been directly responsible for multiple emergency medical responses and open-water rescues that have resulted in saving lives and preventing serious injury. In addition to his duties as a Senior Lieutenant, Zolper serves as the Junior Lifeguard Program Coordinator, mentoring the next generation of Dewey Beach lifeguards. A graduate of Cape Henlopen High School and Lynchburg University, Zolper works as a physical education teacher during the offseason. His dedication both on and off the beach has earned him the respect of his colleagues, who cited his exemplary leadership as a key reason for his selection.




