Below was presented and approved back in the winter, and below that is an updated request for this one event.

**15th Annual Dewey Goes Pink 5K Expansion of Premise,
Friday evening October 2 & Saturday daytime, Oct 3, 2026**

In our 15th year we look forward to crossing the \$2.5 Million mark with an event that is a marquee fall attraction to our small town with over 5000 participants this past year, we request the use of our parking lot area (and Saulsbury Street) to host the pig roast portion of the fundraiser for Delaware Breast Cancer Coalition. Our request is for 2 days total, Friday evening, October 2nd from 5pm-9pm for the event registration/packet pick up...and then the usual Saturday event which runs from 11am-4:30pm. We will provide fence barricades approved by the Delaware ABCC/DATE & portable toilets. The Saturday race begins at 11am, and entire area will be cleaned up and over by 5pm same evening. DE State Police and DELDOT are both on hand to assist with this event each year. Raising \$385,000 last year alone, the total in the first 14 years surpasses \$2,300,000.00 from this event for the DBCC.

We are requesting a minor 'edit' to the request by adding a "Kids Zone" area for this coming event. After walking the area, and the fact we already have Bayard Avenue closed for the event, our request is to extend the area of Bayard another HALF Block from Saulsbury Street to Cajun Cove area, to use that area for a "Kids Zone" on the street, with activities for kids along with ice cream service.

The street is closed already from Swedes to Saulsbury for our event, so we'd just be adding another half a block, and this is only on Race Day Saturday, not registration on Friday.

To: Town of Dewey Beach Commissioners & Town Manager

Re: Adding a Kids Zone, and Schedule update for set up/break down of event

This year we are adding to our already approved event request to add a ‘Kids Zone’ of 2-3 inflatables in the area just past the race finish line. This would be between Saulsbury Street and Cajun Cove on Bayard Avenue for the hours of the race itself. 10am-2pm.

In addition, we wanted to be fully transparent on the timing it takes to host an event this large. Being our 15th year, we’ve learned in previous years what it takes to make the event flow smoothly for all involved. We appreciate the Town of Dewey Beach working so well with us to accomplish this huge undertaking, especially at a time of year we are very light on staffing. What we’ve learned in previous years is we need adequate set up time before the crowds arrive, our request is to set up the stage area on private Izzy Plaza parking property, and some of the tents for registration & food service earlier, portable toilets on private property behind Izzy Plaza, so that we get the bigger items done early for everyone’s safety. We are requesting to set up these items on Thursday afternoon. At no time would Saulsbury Street bayside close during this set up Thursday. With over 5000 shirts/packets to organize for the packet-pick up/registration that starts on Friday early afternoon, this is super helpful to be fully organized for the thousands arriving early Friday. The rest of the set up will take place Friday morning. At that time Dewey Police have been terrific in helping us by closing off Saulsbury Street bayside to vehicular traffic except for those who are homeowners. Even the homeowners have worked very well with us to move their vehicles those two days off the street as to avoid any issues. Our request is being edited to ask that we prioritize public safety by using this schedule (below) for setting up a few things on Thursday afternoon, without any street closures, Then, for Friday, we have submitted a

request and received approval from the Town Manager on July 31, 2026, for our request to have an officer present from 9 am - 9 pm to assist with the closure of Saulsbury Street at Highway One and assist with any local homeowner traffic that entire day.

We have everything fully cleaned up by 6pm or so on Saturday night for the street to be fully reopened.

So that you can fully understand the undertaking to make this all happen, and the organization our team has developed, below is our schedule for this entire event.
